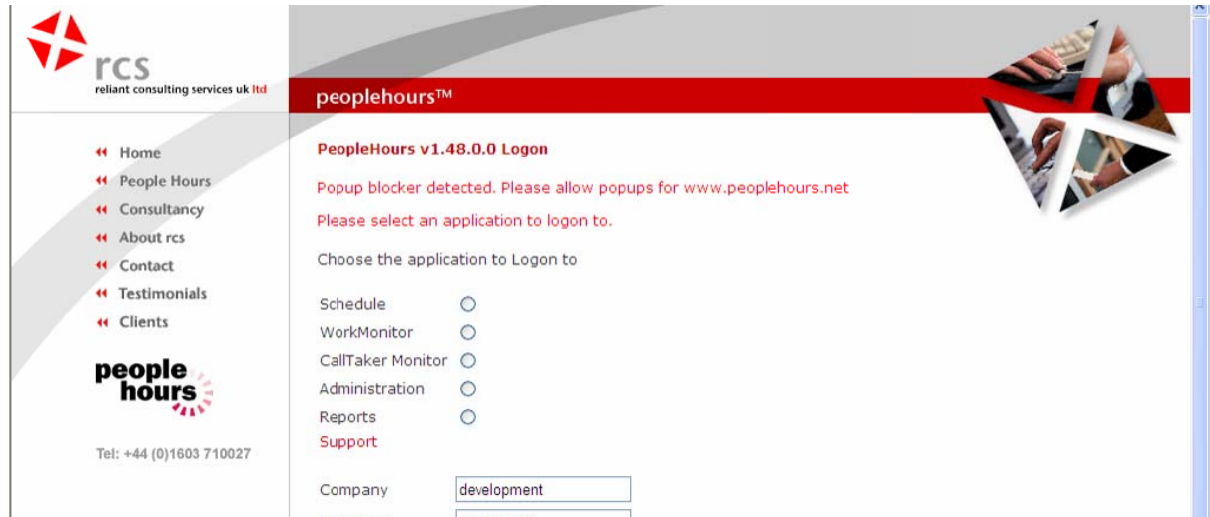


## Pop Up Blockers

Peoplehours uses pop-up windows throughout the application.

When the application starts a check is performed to check that application pop-ups are not blocked.



If pop-ups are blocked, a warning is displayed in the screen and the application will not let you proceed until this pop-up blocker has been disabled for the peoplehours site.

It is not possible at this time for peoplehours to identify which application/s are causing the problem

Please be aware that there are many applications which can block pop-ups, e.g. Anti-Virus, Anti-Spam and Anti-Spyware applications.

As such it is simply not possible to provide detailed instructions for allowing peoplehours pop-ups and disabling the blocker.

Our experience suggests that the following applications, in order of the most common first, are most likely the cause.

**Windows Explorer** – Disable via: - Tools, pop-up blocker, allow pop-up for this site

**Google Toolbar, Yahoo Toolbar, Norton Internet Security, Norton 360** - Please refer to the applications own instructions for enabling pop-ups in these systems.
